

TOWN OF WEST POINT
PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING

The Town of West Point Planning Commission met on Thursday, May 27, 1993 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The meeting was posted in three places.

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the meeting of the Town of West Point Planning Commission was called to order by Fred Madison. Planning Commission members present were: Dave Cole, Joyce Sinkule, Fred Madison, Roger Ballweg, Alan Boehmer and Doug Richmond. Sarah Boehmer-Secretary was present, and Fred Thistle representing the Town Board.

The Daniel Thompson variance was discussed. Concerns of the commission were discussed with Mr. Thompson last week by Fred Madison. There was discussion and a motion was made by Alan Boehmer, 2nd by Roger Ballweg - the motion was passed without opposition. Joyce Sinkule abstained.

The Schoepp rezoning request will be addressed by the commission after the public hearing has occurred. At that time the commission and board will have 30 days to respond.

Old Business discussed:

Discussed the Ferry View (?new name) development and water drainage and erosion problems were discussed. Commission members have been requested to do site visits. The town engineer is inspecting and will file a report with the town board.

Future Land Use Plan Development was discussed. The Towns of Merrimac and Lodi plans will be discussed as examples. Copies will be provided and commission members will review these for discussion at the next meeting.

There was a motion to adjourn by Roger Ballweg, 2nd by Joyce Sinkule, motion carried unanimously.
