

TOWN OF WEST POINT  
PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING

The Town of West Point Planning Commission met on Thursday, February 10, 1994 at 8:10 p.m. at the Town Hall. The meeting was posted in three places.

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the meeting of the Town of West Point Planning Commission was called to order by Dave Cole. The Planning Commission members present were: Joyce Sinkule, Dave Cole, Alan Boehmer, Doug Richmond, and Roger Ballweg. Also present was Sarah Boehmer - secretary.

A motion was made by Joyce Sinkule to table the minutes until next meeting, 2nd by Alan Boehmer - motion carried.

Robbie Buchanan presented a request for placement of a trailer (mobile home) on his property on Hwy. J while he builds his home. He has requested an extension of the mobile home allowance up to three years, rather than the present six months that is allowed by Columbia County. After discussion the Planning Commission at the present time will leave it at 6 months with the possibility of future re-evaluation.

Henry Schwartz certified survey was discussed. No action was taken at this meeting.

The town history was discussed for the Land Plan. Dave Cole is compiling this for the land plan and will provide Fred Madison with an outline.

The possible need for including a statement in the Land Plan re: property lines and maintenance responsibilities was discussed.

There was discussion re: public Lands as outlines by Dave Cole.

No building permits were received.

The Badger Pools building was discussed. No building permit was received by the commission. Joyce Sinkule made a site visit and there was discussion re: the question of water run off being redirected to adjoining properties.

A motion was made by Joyce Sinkule to adjourn the meeting at 10:00 p.m., 2nd by Alan Boehmer - motion carried.
