

TOWN OF WEST POINT
PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING

The Town of West Point Planning Commission met on Thursday, March 24, 1994 at 8:10 p.m. at the Town Hall. The meeting was posted in three places.

Pursuant to the Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the meeting of the Town of West Point Planning Commission was called to order by Fred Madison. The Planning Commission members present were: John Sweeney, Joyce Sinkule, Fred Madison, and Dave Cole. Absent: Roger Ballweg, Alan Boehmer, and Secretary Sarah Boehmer.

The minutes of the previous three meetings were read. Motion to approve by Joyce Sinkule, second by John Sweeney. Motion carried.

Bob Daehling was present to gain information regarding the commission's opinion for a land split and zoning change for 70 acres of the Willard Davis property, located in Section 35-10-7. The land split would entail two 35-acre parcels, one of which would involve a second split. A driveway easement would also be required.

Paul Miller presented his plan to place a cattle shed on tillable land located across a town road from his other buildings. The commission has no concern regarding this matter, except the Soil Erosion Ordinance and the potential runoff from the concrete yard surrounding part of the building.

From previous meetings, discussion continued regarding the land use plan. Fred Madison is continuing to write a basic outline of the land use plan.

A motion was made by Fred Madison, seconded by John Sweeney to adjourn the meeting at 9:20 p.m. Motion carried.
