

TOWN OF WEST POINT  
Planning Commission Meeting

The Town of West Point Planning Commission met on Thursday, June 9, 1994 at 8:20 PM at the Town Hall. The meeting was posted in three places.

Pursuant to the Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the meeting of the Town of West Point Planning Commission was called to order by Fred Madison. The Planning Commission members present were Fred Madison, Roger Ballweg, Doug Richmond, Dave Cole, and Joyce Sinkule. Resigned: Alan Boehmer and Secretary Sarah Boehmer.

The minutes of the previous meetings were tabled until the next meeting.

The following building permits were assigned to Commission members so that a property inspection can be made to determine any soil erosion problems, if any.

The request by Roger Ballweg to rezone approximately 15 acres was discussed. Mr. Ballweg will seek rezoning of approximately one acre where a potential residence would be constructed, leaving the remaining acreage zoned agriculture. The application for rezoning should be corrected to clearly define the location of the approximate one acre, then have the Planning Commission take action at the next meeting.

Fred Madison will obtain a copy of an application form from the Town Clerk, which will serve as a guideline for people making application to build in the Town of West Point.

Fred Madison discussed the possibility of having large-parcel land owners attend a Planning Commission meeting, to receive the land owners' input regarding the highest and best use of the land which they own. The objective is citizen input for an effective and reasonable land use plan, and for the protection and best use of various land types.

The next meeting will include the correction and/or approval of the proposed Re-zoning Application for the Town of West Point form, and selection of the possible citizens to be invited to appear at a future Planning Commission meeting.

The meeting was adjourned at 9:50 PM. Motion by Dave Cole, second by Doug Richmond. Motion carried.
