

**TOWN OF WEST POINT**

**PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING  
JANUARY 27, 2000**

Pursuant to Wisconsin State Statute 19.84, the meeting of the Town of West Point Planning Commission was convened at the Town Hall on January 27, 2000, at 8:10 PM. The meeting was posted in three places. The meeting was called to order by Fred Madison. Planning Commission members present were Gordon Carncross, Cliff Lawton, Fred Madison, Dick O'Connor, Doug Richmond and Joyce Sinkule. Also present was Town Board Member, Alan Treinen.

Agenda Item #2: Public Hearing for Jeffrey and Doreen Sieburg: Jeffrey Sieburg gave a brief overview of the variance being requested. Mr. Jacobsen, a neighbor, was present and had no objections to the variance request. A brief discussion was held among the Commission members and the Sieburg's answered questions. The public hearing was closed at 8:20 p.m.

Agenda Item #3: Approve Minutes: Dick O'Connor made a motion to approve the minutes of January 13, 2000, seconded by Doug Richmond. Motion carried. 6-0

Agenda Item #5: Variance for Jeffrey and Doreen Sieburg: Discussion continued regarding the variance request. Main objection expressed was that if the variance is granted it now goes with the land and cannot be reversed. After further discussion, Dick O'Connor made a motion to grant the variance in the interest of making the lot legal with non-conforming usage, seconded by Doug Richmond. Motion carried. 6-0

Agenda Item #7: Next Meeting Agenda (February 10, 2000): Utility District and 35 Acre Rule.

Agenda Item #9: Adjourn Meeting. Due to the circumstance that the Town Hall was without heat, the remaining items on the agenda were tabled until the next meeting. Motion to adjourn by Dick O'Connor, seconded by Joyce Sinkule. Motion approved 6-0 at 8:30 p.m.
