

MINUTES FROM JUNE MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on June 7, 1983 at 8:30 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte, Earl Lanzendorf, the clerk, treasurer and assessor. Alex Lochner was absent.

The minutes were read and approved.

The treasurers report was read - operating money = \$13,028.46; revenue sharing = \$4,040.09; holding tank savings = \$133.96; and \$3,862.43 in savings. Motion by Robert Lichte, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the treasurer report, motion carried.

Correspondence was read, discussed and place on file.

The Columbia County Sheriff - Armin Ohnesorge came and talked to the concerned citizens on the security of West Point. He explained how the department worked. If the citizens of West Point have problems and a Lodi phone (592) call Lodi police - they have a direct line to the Columbia County dispatcher; if they have a Sauk phone (643) call Prairie du Sac police or 911 - they will call Columbia County dispatcher. If anyone has any complaints call the sheriff and he will take care of it.

Robert Lichte instructed the Columbia County Highway Department to mow the town road sides one time and one more time at all intersections.

A resolution was read for borrowing X amount of dollars to be used for operating expenses. It was placed on file to be used at a later date.

A resolution on fire signs was read. A motion by Robert Lichte 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to adopt this resolution - motion carried. A copy to be sent to Reuben Damm and Robert Irwin.

Bob Lichte to check with Mr. Mead of the Lodi Fire Department on bills to be send with Lodi Ambulance at one time.

Discussion on having our minutes of our town meetings published in the local newspaper. The clerk to check with The Lodi Enterprise and the Star from Sauk City on the cost of publication, and bring to our next meeting.
