

MINUTES FROM JULY MEETING

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on July 5, 1983 at 8:30 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte, Earl Lanzendorf, Alex Lochner, the clerk, treasurer and assessor.

A moment of silent prayer for Esther Rindle was held; also a moment of silent prayer for Alvin Gasser.

The minutes were read and approved.

The treasurers report was read - operating money - \$9,704.55; revenue sharing - \$3,338.03; and holding tank - \$133.96. Motion by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the treasurer report, motion carried.

Correspondence was read, discussed and placed on file. A letter from the Star was read concerning adopting a 9 p.m. curfew for the sale of liquor - Motion was made by Robert Lichte, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf no to adopt the 9 p.m. curfew, motion carried.

Motion was made Alex Lochner, 2nd by Robert Lichte to send the clerk to a election workshop on July 21, at McFarland and the expenses to be paid by the town of West Point - motion carried.

Resolution was read for borrowing \$40,000.00 to pay expenses for the township for the coming year. (for roads--rebuilding etc.) Discussion followed and a motion was made by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to borrow \$40,000.00 for 16 months motion carried. animously.

The chairman reported the Dan Schoepp would like to rezone his land from Agricultural to Commercial, there will be a rezoning meeting at Columbia county on this issue, one of our board will attend.

Robert Lichte would like to thank the 4-H for doing a nice job in cleaning our town hall, also instructed the clerk to purchase a broom, dust pan, trash basket and trash bags. Motion was made by Robert Lichte, 2nd by Alex Lochner, motion carried.
