

MINUTES FROM AUGUST MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on August 2, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte, Alex Lochner, Earl Lanzendorf, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The minutes were read and approved.

The treasurers report was read - operating money - \$39,956.17; revenue sharing - \$2,088.83; holding tank - \$133.96 and tax account - \$20.26. Motion by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the treasurer report, motion carried.

Correspondence was read, discussed and placed on file. A petition signed by all families but one not to put a stop signs on Slack Road and Hillcrest Drive, there will be not stop signs put up at this time. A copy of the petition will be sent to the other family.

A survey map was received from Mid State Associates, Inc. - the Okee store is in the Town of West Point - The Town of Lodi has been collecting the taxes on the store. Robert Lichte will talk to the Town of Lodi concerning this matter.

Motion by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Robert Lichte to pay the bills, motion carried. A bill to be send to Jeff Karls for \$100.00 for fire rescue for a auto accident.

A financial report was given as bad bookkeeping - General account - \$4,012.92 and Revenue Sharing - \$502.40 this is from the State of Wisconsin Auditor.

51 letters have been sent to people who are delinquent in Personal Property Taxes (app. \$6,900.00).

Insurance policies were discussed - it is tabled until our September meeting to get more information from an insurance company.

Eight names were read who have applied for the job at our sanitary landfill (Paul Benish-City of Lodi; Mike Clark-Town of West Point; Roger Drake-Town of Lodi; Ronald Hauge-Rio; George Markee-City of Lodi; Harley Mitchell-City of Lodi; Pat Pelletier-City of Lodi; Ernest Pulfus-Town of Dane) a vote was taken from the board with Mike Clark receiving 2 votes and Harley Mitchell receiving 1 vote. Mike Clark will be our new Sanitary Landfill Operator (he will be on probation until January 1, 1984 to reviewed at that time).

A letter was received from Clifford and Leah Schweppe that 4 dogs had attacked their flock of sheep killing 17 lambs and 5 ewes. The town board signed a letter stating that this was correct and would be sent to Columbia County for payment.

Bud Styer from Woodlake Trails asked to have reflector poles before each curve going into Woodlake Trails - Robert Lichte said he would check with Columbia County, he (Bud Styer) asked how you get a person deputized - ask Columbia County Sheriff, also he would like to have Bingo at Woodlake Trails - it is state regulated and he has to apply for this (the town board has nothing to say about this)

Motion by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner to adjourn our meeting to September 6, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. motion carried
