

MINUTES FROM OCTOBER MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on October 4, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The minutes were read and approve.

The Treasurers report was read - operating money-\$39,625.14; revenue sharing - \$2,116.68; holding tank-\$133.96; tax account - \$20.26. Motion by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Alex Lochner to accept the treasurer report - motion carried.

Correspondence was read, discussed and placed on file.

Delinquent personal property taxes werediscussed. The board is going to check with the lawyer from the towns association on how to handle our personal property taxes.

A motion by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Alex Lochner to approve Russell Morter request to put a mobile home on his land for farm use only, motion carried. A letter to be sent to Robert Irwin.

A report was given on the meeting on emergency government. The fire and ambulance departments handle most of emergency.

Attorney Don Ryan gave a report on the action concerning open meeting law. A motion was made by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Alex Lochner to continue negotiations, motion carried.

It was decided to have a special open town meeting on Tuesday, November 1, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. to decide if to go to nomination papers. There will be a regular town meeting following this meeting. Also, there will be a special town meeting on Tuesday, October 18, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. to discuss budget, etc.
