

MINUTES FROM SPECIAL OCTOBER MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on October 18, 1983 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer and Hary Sawyer-Assessor.

The minutes were read and approved with corrections.

Treasurers report was read - operating money-\$32,950.06; holding tank-\$133.96 and tax account-\$20.26. Motion by Alex Lochner to accept the treasurer report, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf, motion carried.

Harry Sawyer stated that by January, 1986 the appraised value has to be 100%. It was decided to send a letter along with the tax bills explaining this to the people

It was suggested that the town could have volunteer landowners do brushing along the roads.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to the clerk to a workshop and pay expenses - motion carried.

The town board worked on the budget for 1984.
