The minutes were read and a motion by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was read - operating money-\$64,426.36; holding tank-\$137.58 and tax account-\$20.26. Motion by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd Alex Lochner to accept treasurer report, motion carried.

Correspondence - was read and placed on file. A letter was read giving the town of West Point a lot at ElRay - a motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner to table the deed to be checked out for ~~our January~~ ^{a later} meeting - motion carried.

A roll call vote was taken for 3 to 5 person board - Earl Lanzendorf-Yes; Bob Lichte-No; and Alex Lochner-No - the 3 to 5 person board was defeated.

A motion was made to accept to town budget of \$63,505.28 by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner motion carried. (a copy of budget in the minutes books)

A motion was made by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to hire an outside firm to do our assessing to 100% full evaluation - motion carried.

Woodlake Trails portable snack wagon liquor license was revoked as of December 6, 1983, a letter was sent state of Wisconsin stating that it was revoked.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Alex Lochner to put a \$15.00 snow plowing bill on John Forseth tax bill, motion carried.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Bob Lichte, to approve Ryan Farms to place a mobile home for farm help only was approved - motion carried. A letter will be sent to Columbia County zoning.

A resolution was present stating that the town is responsible for county and state taxes - Motion by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the resolution the motion was carried.

A motion was made Alex Lochner, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to put a stock pile of sand at the landfill site - motion carried.

The town board has authorized Jim Meister to plow Pleasant View Park for the winter.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte, 2nd Alex Lochner to put a letter in with the tax notices explaining that the town of West Point is hiring an outside firm to do the reassessing of our town, motion carried.

Bud Styer from Woodlake Trails explained that he is in the process of purchasing 70 acres from Willard Davis to be zoned from agricultural to recreational there will be 300 - 400 camp sites.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to adjourn our meeting until January 3, 1984, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf, motion carried.
