

MINUTES FROM FEBRUARY MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on February 7, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer Assessor, and Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor was absent.

A moment of silent prayer for Earl Lanzendorf's mother was held.

The minutes were read for the January 3, 1984 meeting and the January 18, 1984 - a Motion by Bob Lichte to approve the minutes from both meetings, 2nd by Alex Lochner the motion was carried.

The Treasurers report was read - General Account - \$62,212.45, Holding Tank - \$137.58, Savings (Tax Account)- \$23.33. A motion by Bob Lichte , 2nd by Alex Lochner to accept the treasurer report - motion carried.

Correspondence - A check for \$100.00 from the City of Madison on a Ambulance refund for Bret Schuhart was received.

A letter from Lakepoint Realty asking if the town board had any objections on rezoning one acre of land for the Michael Rodenschmit's - Bob Lichte stated it was up to Columbia County Zoning first and then the board would take action.

A letter from Lodi Fire Department stating that the rural fire numbering system needed to revised.

Chairman Bob Lichte stated that a Sentry Stand could not be placed on Gannon Road - as you can not close a town road.

Four Operators Licenses applications were presented - Judy Fritz, Teresa Beardsley, Jil Elser and Jeffrey Elser. A motion was made by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Bob Lichte to approve the applications - motion carried.

Ron Gerbar (new owner of the Ferry Landing snack building) had asked if he could have a package license for beer - a motion by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Alex Lochner to have him operate for one year and at that time they would reconsider the license for package beer - motion carried.

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Chairman Bob Lichte stated that the town needed to update the town ordinances- at a later date the board will have a meeting to go over the ordinances.

A motion by Bob Lichte, 2nd by Alex Lochner to adjourn our meeting, motion carried.
