A motion was made by Rudy Oest to change the annual meeting to the 2nd Tuesday in April at 8:00 p.m., 2nd by Roger Ballweg, 17 yes and 11 no - motion was carried.

A motion was made by Maurice Neumaier to change our regular monthly board meeting to the first Thursday after the first Tuesday at 8:00 p.m., 2nd by Dave Treinen - motion carried.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to have an open meeting on November 8, 1984 for setting tax levy - 2nd by Bob Nelson - motion carried.

It was announced that everyone will receive cards stating the total value of their property 10 days before open book - open book will be 2 or 3 days in August - any complaints filed then for the Board of Review.

Harry Sawyer stated that it is a state law to have a fire permit.
