

MINUTES FROM APRIL MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on Thursday, April 5, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The minutes were read from the March 6 meeting - a motion by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was read - General Account - \$78,590.74; Holding Tank - \$137.58; Tax Account - \$2,412.58 A motion by Alex Lochner to approve the treasurers report, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Correspondence was read - A board of review workshop will be held for clerk, chairman and supervisors on April 13, 20, 27 and May 4 - if anyone would like to go the town will pay mileage, registration and lunch.

A letter from the Lodi Fire Department stating that they need a new pumper fire truck - the letter stated it would 18 to 24 months before the purchase would be made.

A motion by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner to pay the bills, motion carried.

In the near future there will be a tour of town roads to check on which ones need repair. We have one bid on doing the roads and some estimates all from independent companies.

At the annual meeting on April 3, 1984 it was decided to change our regular meeting to the first Thursday after the first Tuesday at 8:00 p.m.; our annual meeting will be the second Tuesday in April at 8:00 p.m.; and our next open meeting for public input will be November 8, 1984 for the budget hearing preceding our regular meeting.

The Sanitary Landfill will open on April 18, 1984 from 2:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m. , also it will be open on Saturday as usual from 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.

David Pryse, the assessor the Town hired to do the reassessing of our town explained that most of his ground work is done and that he will be start reassessing as of May 1, 1984.

The fire numbering system was discussed - Earl Lanzendorf explained that at the time they were purchased there was a open town meeting and it was decided that the numbers could be placed on the house or by the road. It was suggested that maybe our assessor could take the sign and number when they did the reassessing - the fire numbering system was tabled to a later date.

The resolution of Woodlake Trails rezoning 70 acres of land from agricultural to recreational was presented - Chairman Bob Lichte stated he would step aside and refrain from voting due to conflict of interest. Hearing no objection Chairman Bob Lichte still conducted the meeting - he called for a written vote - Alex Lochner - NO, Earl Lanzendorf - NO, the petition was defeated.

A motion to adjourn our meeting until May 3, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. was made by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner, motion carried.
