

MINUTES FROM JUNE MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point met at the town hall on Thursday, June 7, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The minutes were read from the May 3rd meeting - a motion by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf the motion carried.

The Treasurers report was read - General Account - \$73,723.68 Holding Tank - \$141.45; and Tax Account - \$3,906.34 A motion by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the treasurers report - 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Correspondence - A letter was read from Robert Lichte stating why he did not vote on Woodlake Trails rezoning petition.

A motion by Earl Lanzendorf to pay the bills, 2nd by  
Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Fire Numbers were discussed - Alex Lochner reported that  
Ace Hardware would have to through Lange Enterprises to get  
numbers - therefore we should just go through Lange Enterprises  
our selves. Alex also stated that Sauk County signs were bigger  
and had the name of the road on the sign also. The fire signs  
were tabled until June 21, 1984

A rezoning petition for Frank Pustaver to go from  
Agricultural to Single Family Residence - Bob Lichte voted  
YES - is a home area already; Alex Lochner voted YES - been  
developed and Earl Lanzendorf voted YES - as part of a plat.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to have three (3) people  
to work at the September Election, 2nd by Alex Lochner -  
motion carried.

A report was given that to refinish the town hall floor  
would be \$.60 sq. ft. and to have the floor carpeted would be  
\$.78 sq. ft. After some discussion a motion was made by Earl  
Lanzendorf to carpet the town hall floor and also put up no  
smoking signs, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A report was given on town roads - A motion was made by  
Bob Lichte to have Columbia County resurface Chrisler Road  
from County J to Van Ness Road 1.2 miles, 2nd by Alex Lochner  
motion carried. Also a motion was made by Bob Lichte to  
resurface Reynolds Road from Highway 60 to Lovering Road by  
Scott Construction Inc. from Lake Delton, WI. at approximate  
cost per mile of \$5,730.00 - total mileage of 1.9 miles, 2nd  
by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A appointment of an Advisory citizen committee was made - for ONE YEAR - 3 members to expire April election 1985 are: Dave Cole, Fred Madison and Sid Teidman; TWO YEARS - 2 members to expire April, 1986 are Bernie Treinen and Hal Minkler - they will have there first meeting on June 21, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. and after which they will meet two weeks after each town board meeting - no fee will be paid but any expenses will be paid. A motion by Alex Lochner to approve the above committee, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to approve Lake Wisconsin Marina a Class B Beer license with new officers, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The following Operators Licenses were presented for Lake Wisconsin Marina - Mark Downer, Clifford Jacobs and Mary Jacobs - a motion was made by Bob Lichte to grant the licenses 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The following Operators Licenses were presented for Woodlake Trails Inc. - Nancy Norton, Brian Zeman, Peter Wanat, Terri Nash and Raeanne Randall - a motion was made by Alex Lochner to grant these licenses, 2nd by Bob Lichte, motion carried.

Bud Styer had a presentation on Woodlake Trails - he showed a film explaining Woodlake Trails. He also stated that the D.N.R. had closed his dump and that he would be using our town dump - he asked if he could dump in a certain place and at no cost to the town would hire a cat to cover the trash. After discussion - he will have to have his garbage sorted the same way everyone else in the town.

Bud Styer also asked if 2 or 3 street lights could be placed on Gannon Road to Hwy. 60 and Woodlake Trails would pay the expense of the street lights.

Discussion also followed on having Schoepp Road posted as NO PARKING as when Woodlake Trails has there fireworks display a lot of cars park along the road.

It was asked to have the bridge at Merrimac put on the agenda for our July meeting for discussion.

There will be a special meeting on June 21, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. to install the citizen committee, street lights being placed on Gannon Road, landfill sorting, fire numbers and having Schoepp Road posted NO PARKING.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to adjourn our meeting, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.
