

MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, September 6, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

A motion by Alex Lochner to approve the August 9, 1984 minutes, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was read - General Account - \$83,729.00, Holding Tank Account - \$141.45 and Tax Account - \$29.58. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to accept the Treasurers report 2nd by Bob Lichte - motion carried.

Robert Irwin was not able to be at this meeting but will be at the October 4, 1984 meeting.

Robert Daehling stated that there will not be an increase in our insurance premium. There will be an insurance auditor here on Wednesday - September 12, at 8:00 a.m. to look over the clerk's books.

The City of Lodi and the Town of Lodi approved the purchase of a new fire truck - therefore the Town of West Point paid the Lodi Fire department there share \$2000.00.

A letter was read from the Village of Merrimac asking the Town of West Point to approve a resolution to have a bridge across the Wisconsin River. It was decided not to made any decision at this time.

There will be a September Primary Election on September 11, 1984 from 9:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. A motion was made by Bob Lichte to give the election workers their evening meal, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to approve a one day picnic beer license for Lake Wisconsin Boat Club, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Terry Gannon had asked to be placed on the agenda in regard to the Sentry Stand at Woodlake Trails being on a Town Road - The Sentry Stand has been removed and a Town Ordinance will be made not to have anything on a town road at a later date.

There will be a ordinance presented at a later date on bar closing time to be 1:00 a.m. with the exception of New Year's Eve.

A reminder was made that the town board bring in their salary and bills for the last 3 months.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to adjourn our meeting 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.
