

MINUTES FROM OCTOBER MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, October 4, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Harry Sawyer-Assessor, and Margaret Hanson- Treasurer was absent.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the September 6, 1984 minutes, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was read - General - \$89,610.65, Holding Tank - \$141.45 and Tax Account - \$25.00. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to accept the treasurers report, 2nd by Bob Lichte - motion carried.

2 letters were received from State Superintendent of Public Instruction- one on 3 roads to be put in Sauk Prairie School from River Valley (referred back to the school) and the other letter of denied permission to leave Lodi School to go to Waunakee.

There will be a Zoning meeting on October 15, 1984 for William J. and Donna M. Skoumal from Downers Grove, Illinois at the County Administration Building at 7:30 p.m. for County Board of Adjustments. (variance to Chapter 11.17.1 (b) Class A Highways)

There will be a election on November 6, 1984 from 8:00 a.m.- 8:00 p.m. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner to have new people to help count ballots at \$3.55 per hour - motion carried.

On November 8, 1984 there will be a open town meeting to set the tax levy for 1985 - immediately following will be the regular board meeting.

On December 6th, 1984 will be a public hearing input for the budget of 1985 at 7:45 p.m. - with the regular board meeting following.

Mr. Robert Irwin explained the new composting system that is being tried in Columbia County. It is a State project - the cities that will be the trial cities are: City of Madison, City of Lodi, City of Prairie Du Sac and the City of Poynette. The cost will be \$10.00 a ton. Sorting of refuse is very important in composting.

An ordinance was read to have the bars closing at 1:00 a.m. all year except on New Years Eve. Mr. Styer from Woodlake Trails stated that would be no problem as far as his bar, Alice Elser from Hickory Hills - stated she didn't want to be the only bar open. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to adopt the Ordinance upon publication, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Another ordinance was presented and read about not placing any sign, building etc. on the town road or right a way. After some discussion this ordinance was tabled.

The Lodi ambulance budget was presented - the Town of West Point share for 1985 including a new ambulance is \$13,250.00. A motion was made by Bob Lichte to accept the ambulance budget, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The Lodi fire department presented ~~their~~ budget for 1985 - the Town of West Point share for 1985 including a new fire truck is \$20,435.40. A motion was made by Bob Lichte to accept the fire deparment budget, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to adjourn our meeting, 2nd by Bob Lichte - motion carried.
