

MINUTES FROM SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town of West Point held a Special Town Meeting on Thursday, November 8, 1984 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall.

The minutes were read from the April 3, 1984 meeting - a motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes - motion carried.

There were 18 people present.

After some discussion a motion was made for a referendum on the April 2, 1985 Spring election to ask the people their feeling if the Sauk and Lodi fire districts and the ambulance districts should each have a separate mill rate on ~~their~~ ^{their} tax bills, the motion was made by Maurice Neumaier, 2nd by Margaret Hanson - Yes 18 - No 0 - motion carried. *Rescinded on March 7, 1985.*

The question of raising the Administrative Salaries was brought up - a motion was made by Rudy Oest to leave the salaries the same - 2nd by Maurice Neumaier - Rudy Oest withdrew his motion and Maurice Neumaier withdrew his 2nd. A motion was made to increase the Clerk's salary by Rudy Oest of \$1,200 2nd by Tom Eberle - Yes 13 - No 2 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Rudy Oest to increase the Treasurers salary \$900.00, 2nd by Walter Peterson - Yes 14=No - 1 - motion carried.

A motion was made by Rudy Oest to have no other salaries increases - the motion was withdrawn. A motion was made by Maurice Neumaier to increase the Assessor salary \$500.00 the first year and \$500.00 more the 2nd year - 2nd by Frederick Heine - Yes 15 - No - 2 - motion carried

A motion was made by Rudy Oest to have no more raises for the Supervisors and the Chairman - 2nd by Maurice Neumaier - Yes - 7 = No - 4 - the motion was carried.

The Town of West Point will receive \$4,736.00 approximately from Federal Revenue Sharing - after some discussion a motion was made by Rudy Oest to put the Federal Revenue Funds toward our town roads - 2nd by Harry Sawyer - motion carried.

A motion was made by Rudy Oest to approve the tax levy for 1985 of \$50,188.70, 2nd by Sid Tiedman - Yes 18 - No 0 --- motion carried.

A motion was made by Walter Peterson to adjourn the meeting - 2nd by Rudy Oest - Yes 18 - No 0 - motion carried.
