

MINUTES FROM NOVEMBER MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of West Point held its regular monthly meeting immediately following the Special Town Meeting on Thursday, November 8, 1984. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes from the October 4 and October 25, 1984 meeting, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was read - General-\$71,649.19; Holding Tank-\$141.45 and Tax Account-\$25.00. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to accept the treasurers report, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Earl Lanzendorf gave a report about the Board of Adjustments meeting - asking for a variance of a setback of 100 feet from center-line of highway 188. A letter from Columbia County Zoning Department was received on October 18, 1984 stating that a setback was granted for 95 feet from centerline of highway.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to pay the bills - 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to reject the deed for a AleRay Lot - Parcel #23 because lots 42 - 61 all have deeds to that parcel as a right of way, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte not to join the State Dwelling Code at this time, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The clerk was instructed to make copies of the ground water bill and send to the supervisors to read and to make a decision at the December 6, 1984 meeting.

A Operator License application was received from Gary Downer for Hickory Hills - a motion was made by Bob Lichte to grant the operator license, 2nd by Alex Lochner motion carried.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to except the 1985 Budget that was presented (\$50,188.70), 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to adjourn the meeting 2nd by Bob Lichte - motion carried.
