

MINUTES FROM JANUARY MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday - January 3, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk; members absent were Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The minutes were read and a motion by Bob Lichte to approve the minutes - 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The clerk gave the Treasurers report of General fund - \$82,218.62; Holding Tank - \$195.46 and Tax Account - \$29.99 a motion was made by Bob Lichte to accept the treasurers report, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to pay off the loan in March after tax settlement (at Bank of Lodi) 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A letter was read from Rasmussen and Associates (Duffy Rasmussen) stating how good the work on the town roads was done.

A letter was read from Federal Revenue Sharing that we will receive a total of \$5,211.00 for 1985 (1st quarter payment of \$1,302.00, 2nd quarter payment of \$1,302.00, 3rd quarter payment of \$1,302.00 and 4th quarter payment of \$1,305.00).

There was a letter read from Michael Zitnick on water quality in the bay, the land was purchased by Mr. Paul R. Abley.

A letter from Edie Klammer on a lot in Pleasant View park - if the town would be interested in purchasing the land to be used as a parking lot - it was decided not to purchase the land at this time.

There will be a Board of Adjustments meeting on Monday, January 14, 1985 - will check with Columbia County Zoning on this matter. Mr. Wallace J. Bauer would like a variance of 35 feet from center of road to build a garage.

Chairman Bob Lichte ask*the Supervisors to think on how they wanted to draft a referendum for the April 2, election, it will be done at the February 7th meeting.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to audit the clerks and treasurers books on January 10, 1985 at 7:30 p.m at the clerks home - 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Fred Thistle stated that there was some fill dirt between Hickory Hills and Sunset Harbor Marina - Bob Lichte to check with Columbia County on this - also Bob Lichte to ask Columbia County to plow our town hall driveway.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to adjourn our meeting - 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.
