

MINUTES FROM MARCH MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday - March 7, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

Some corrections were made in the February 7, minutes (what was corrected was made in yellow that was deleted). A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes with corrections, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The Treasurer gave the following report: General-\$75,071.38; Tax Account - \$902.56 and Holding Tank - \$195.46. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to accept the Treasurer report, 2nd by Bob Lichte - motion carried. The Treasurer also stated that the town was going to have to pick up \$6,713.36 in Personal Property taxes not paid. She also stated she was going to do her best to collect these taxes.

A letter was read from Lange Enterprises stating that they would update the towns fire numbers, maps etc. This was tabled until a later date as it was not on the agenda.

There will be a meeting with Columbia County Highway Department and the Town Board of Lodi and West Point on Tuesday, March 19, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Lodi Fire Station.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to pay the bills, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried

A representative from Batz Sanitary Service from Waunakee gave the Town Board the following prices:

- BUSINESS - 1 yard - \$28.00
- 1½ yard - \$30.00
- 2 yard - \$32.00
- 3 yard - \$45.00
- 4 yard - \$50.00
- 6 yard - \$60.00
- 8 yard - \$80.00
- 13 yard - \$100.00

Mr. Batz also stated that he picks up about 1/3 of West Point already.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to meet with Bud Styer from Woodlake Trails to work out the landfill situation, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried. The date to be set some time in April.

There was no representative from the Ad Hoc Development Committee at the meeting so it will be put on April agenda.

Chairman Bob Lichte stated that were Zoning changes on Ag2 Land to go from 40 acres to 35 acres - more information will be given at a later date.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to buy the evening meals for the election workers, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Maurice Neumaier withdrew his motion to have a referendum on the April election on splitting the Fire districts, Margaret Hanson withdrew her 2nd to that motion - therefore there will be no referendum at the April election. The reason was that both fire department help each other out - they have a good working relationship.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.
