

MINUTES FROM SPECIAL MARCH MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point and Lodi met at the Lodi Fire Station on Tuesday - March 19, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. All members were present, including clerks.

Elmer Fisk from Columbia County Highway Commission was present to open lines of communication with the county and the townships. Mr. Fisk stated that they have 34 units for snow plowing available. Mr. Fisk explained that there is a highway advance due the Highway Commission of \$200.00 per mile - the county pays back the townships a \$100.00 per mile. Mr. Fisk also stated that the county would help the townships any way they can - by bidding on what roads need to be done and/or help figure out which roads need to be done first and which roads could wait a few years.

Alex Lochner asked Mr. Fish to have the monthly bills for snow plowing, sanding etc. in more detail stating which road was done, how many miles was done, and how much each road cost to be done. Mr. Fisk stated he would send out a more detailed bill from now on.

The meeting adjourned at 9:30 p.m.
