

MINUTES FROM APRIL MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, April 4, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: Robert Lichte-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The minutes were read from the March 7, 1985 - a motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf, motion carried. The minutes were read from the March 19, 1985 special meeting with Columbia County Highway Department - a motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The Treasurer gave the following report: General-\$62,975.45; Holding Tank-\$245.46 and Tax Account-\$902.56. The Treasurer also stated that the town's note with the State Bank of Lodi has been paid in full as of April 2, 1985. A motion was made by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Bob Lichte - to accept the Treasurers report as given - motion carried.

A letter was read from Robert Nichols asking the Town Board to give him a legal right-a-way to cross Mr. Paul Benesh and Dr. Bohlman's land. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to table this matter until a later date, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried. The clerk was instructed to send a letter stating that the board was working on it.

A letter was read from the State of Wisconsin on Property Insurance Fund.

A letter was read from MATC that there is a board member position open - if anyone was interested the clerk has the information.

A letter from the State of Wisconsin on a Public Notice of Pollutant Discharge System Permit Application was filed for Lake Wisconsin via a drainage ditch.

A letter of a Public Hearing of Board of Adjustments will meet on Thursday, April 4 for Wallace J. Bauer of Grafton, Wisconsin. Chairman Bob Lichte stated it was for a garage permit that would be build to close to the road - they would like a variance.
