

MINUTES FROM THE JUNE MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, June 6, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer-Assessor, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor was absent.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes from the May meeting - 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was - General - \$55,188.19; Holding Tank-\$251.36 and the Tax Account - \$1,139.91. A motion was made by John Benish to approve the treasurer report, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A letter was read from Edwin Rodenski who lives on Smith Park Road concerning brush on the road side. Chairman John Benish will look into the matter.

A list of the fire numbers have been redone by the Assessor and the Clerk and are now being checked by the Chairman and the Fire Chief.

Two bids have been received on putting a handicapped entrance in the Town Hall, one bid from Klamer Construction for \$1,785.00 and one bid from Ron Eberle for \$1,085.00. The board decided to table this until the July meeting at which time the bids would include changing the two front doors to open out.

The Town of West Point sign for the Town Hall was discussed, Joe Ballweg had put a bid for \$40.00 to \$50.00 depending on the size of the letters and if painted on the town hall building or on a sheet of metal. It was decided to table this until July meeting - the board was going to see if they could find the old sign.

Earl Lanzendorf and John Benish have gone over all the town roads and have graded them as to the condition the road is in. It was decided to table the roads until the July meeting. Two bids that have been received are from Scott Construction at \$5,500 per mile and Columbia County at \$4,800 per mile (this is a water base), or \$5,776.00 for seal coat.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to pay the bills - 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish announced if anyone knew of a road sign that was missing or in need of repair to contact a member of the board and it will be taken care of.

A application was received from Ron Gerbar for a Class "A" package beer license. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to grant the Class A package beer license, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried. A motion was made by John Benish to set the license fee at \$10.00 a year, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The following operators licenses were received from Woodlake Trails - Nancy Norton, Kellie S.N. Unke, Richard Lochner, Diane Miller, Sonja S. Droste, Judith A. Flinchum, Cathy Niesen, Jay Olson, Sharon Kennedy, Jody Adams, Curtis Gruninger, a motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the licenses, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Randy Styer from Woodlake Trails asked if a center line could be put on the curves going into the park and some signs put up to reduce speed and or caution signs for off road vehicles ahead. After some discussion it was decided the Woodlake Trails would paint the center of the road and the Town will pay for the paint (2 curves), also the town will have some signs put up on the road to reduce speed.

Chairman John Benish stated the the rules for fireworks is very stiff and requires bonding and insurance is necessary. Randy Styer was going to check into what was need to have the fireworks.

Randy Styer also asked if Gannon Road could be posted "NO PARKING SIGNS". A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to allow Gannon Road to be posted No Parking for the fireworks, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to adjourn the meeting until July 11, 1985 at 8:00 p.m., 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.
