

MINUTES FROM THE JULY MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, July 11, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer - Assessor.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes as read from the June meeting - 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was - General-\$59,903.76; Holding Tank-\$251.36; and the Tax Account-\$1,139.91. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to accept the Treasurers report, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish announced that Delmar Phelps property has been sold as of today (July 11, 1985) and with in a month it will be cleaned up. Chairman John Benish also has not been able to get in contact with Robert Jonas regarding Walker's County Dining Restaurant if going to rebuild.

Two bids were received on the handicap entrance and the changing of the two front doors; (1) Ron Eberle-\$1,385.00, (2) Klammer Construction-\$2,504.00. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to table the bids until August 8, 1985 meeting, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to have the following roads repaired in 1985:

- Morter Road - .10 mile = mat
- Smith Park Road - .2 mile = 1/2 mat on corner
- Unke Road 1/5 mile - mat from culver to 188
- Schoepp Road - .8 mile - sealer (Scott Contruction due)
- Chrislaw Road - .5 mile - mat
- Hillcrest - .10 mile - mat

2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The old Town Hall sign has been found - it needs painting otherwise in good shape. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to ask 4H if they were interested in painting the sign if not have Joe Ballweg paint the sign, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish state that he had gone to a Board of Adjustments meeting at Columbia County - Mina Sperling wanted to add a larger garage building back toward her house. Chairman John Benish gave the town's approval.

The following operators licenses were received from Tri-J Inc. (Hickory Hills) - Joan Bartholomew and Terry R. Streeter; A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the licenses, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Ken Foss - the Town of West Point representative to the Lodi Ambulance Board was not present so his report will be tabled until our August 8, 1985 meeting.

Charles Zeman - the Town of West Point representative to the Lodi Fire Board gave a report - one tanker truck is leaking badly and can not be used; the new fire truck (La France) will be getting in October; the towns are to be getting billed for fire runs.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to have "NO PARKING" signs put up on Gannon Road, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

At our August meeting a ordinance will be presented to have Speed Limits signs up on Gannon Road.

Chairman John Benish presented a letter from Miller, Rogers, and Owens of Portage concerning the Fireworks at Woodlake Trails. Chairman John Benish read the Wisconsin Statutes on signing fireworks permits and had designated Bruce Bushnell- to sign or not to sign. The town board decided to take legal action-Wisconsin Statutes states a Federal permit overrides the signed or unsigned permit. Chairman John Benish stated that at the Wisconsin Towns Convention in October that an ordinance on Fireworks for all townships would be worked on.

Margaret Hanson asked if a entrance sign could be placed by Paul Schoepp each way - Chairman John Benish will check with Wisconsin Department of Transportation.

Van Ness Road has vines growing in the road - Chairman John Benish to talk to Columbia County Highway Department.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to adjourn the meeting until August 8, 1985 at 8:00 p.m., 2nd by John Benish - meeting adjourned.
