

MINUTES FROM THE AUGUST MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, August 8, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes from the July Meeting, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was - General-\$133,290.18; Holding Tank-\$251.36; and Tax Account-\$1,139.91. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the Treasurers report, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried. The Town Board would like a copy of who has or has not paid their taxes - will check with County Treasurer to see if possible.

The following bills were presented:

- Highway Commissioner of Columbia County (road and sign repair) - \$914.01
- Lanzendorf Transfer Inc. (Grading & Limestone at Landfill) \$362.22
- Lanzendorf Transfer (Gravel & Grading at Landfill) - \$109.72
- Leon Sweet (mowing at town hall) - \$40.00
- Klamer Construction Co. (work at Town Hall) - \$500.00

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to pay the bills, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried

Ron Eberle withdrew his bid to repair the town hall and a motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept Klamer Construction Co. bid of \$2,504.00 (handicapped ramp and two new front doors that open out), 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Alex Lochner stated that the town board was considering buying the house next to the landfill and using it as town hall but the price was too high for the town to consider to buy.

A operator license for Gail Schoepp was presented - a motion was made by Alex Lochner to grant the license, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A Ordinance was presented to the town board establishing a speed limit on Gannon Road. The speed limit would start before the first curve (35 mph) - the fine of \$35.00 minimum plus \$1.00 per mile over speed limit. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the Speed Limit Ordinance, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried. Ordinance to take effect upon publication.

Ken Foss gave a report from the Ambulance board - the new ambulance will be coming soon. Chris Ness from the Ambulance board would like a map of fire numbers at Pleasant View Park, Woodlake Trails, and Elray if possible. There is no entrance to Rock of Gibraltar Park for the ambulance - Chairman John Benish and Ken Foss will talk to Mr. Horton about crossing his land. Bud Styer asked about having the ambulance on private property during a special event - Chris Ness explained that it was a board rule that the ambulance are not to leave City of Lodi as that is a central area for the district.

Maurice Neumaier asked for the rest of the money that the Town of West Point owes for the Sauk Prairie Ambulance (\$1,444.00). It was not in the town budget - so was tabled until a later date.

Bud Styer would like to rezone some land belonging to Woodlake Trails, Willard Davis, Roger Ballweg, and Gordan Hartmann from agricultural to commercial/recreational - he asked if the Town Board would come and look at what he would like to do. It was decided to meet on Tuesday, August 20, 1985 at 6:30 p.m. at Woodlake Trails to discuss rezoning.

Bud Styer also gave the town board a letter stating that Woodlake Trails had compiled with all the Fire Codes.

Earl Lanzendorf asked to have the signs for school bus stop ahead relocated on Chrisler Road to be placed by Tom Eberle's.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to adjourn our meeting, 2nd by Alex Lochner. - motion carried.
