

MINUTES FROM THE SEPTEMBER MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, September 5, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the August 8, 1985 meeting, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes from the special August 20, meeting, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was - General-\$63,984.55; Holding Tank-\$251.36; and Tax Account-\$1,156.04. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the Treasurers report, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A thank you was received from the Garden Bluff cemetary secretary thanking the town for the donation.

A letter was read from Esther Rindle Estate Lawyer (Hartmann) stating that 10 acres of land including the Sanitary Landfill could be purchased at the price of \$25,000.00. The Landfill is to close as of December 31, 1985 - with a 60-90 days to cover and/or close after December. A transfer site will also be look in to, it is tabled until our next meeting.

The following bills were presented:

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to pay the bills, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

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Alex Lochner thanked Bud Styer for having the town board over to look at the agricultural land that he would like to rezone to recreational. A letter from DNR was presented on ground water etc. A vote was taken from the town board on the rezoning of land - John Benish - No; Alex Lochner - No; and Earl Lanzendorf - No.

Chairman John Benish stated that Schoepp Road needed to have two coats of sealer instead of one coat. Scott Construction quoted the following prices for a mat \$24,000.00 per one mile, if no pot holes can get by with a sealer at \$5,700.00 approximately. In our 1986 budget we need to invest more into our town roads. On October 29, there will be a meeting on cost sharing on roads at the District meeting of the Wisconsin Towns Association.

Lee Rogers presented his driveway problem on Schneller Road - a piece of land 3 ft. by 110 ft long is owned by Dick Hegerfelt - he would like to purchase this piece of land to have a driveway coming out on Schneller Road (for his duplex) otherwise he would have to drive through between his house and garage and come from Golf Road. The town board will investate and have a board meeting on Thursday, September 19, 1985 at 1:00 p.m.

Chairman John Benish stated the Lodi Fire Department had made an inspection of the town hall and stated that Exit Signs, and Fire Extinguishers are needed - they have been ordered.

Gordon Corncross respentative of the Town of West Point was present and he stated the Sauk Prairie Fire Department will have to purchase new helmets.

Earl Lanzendorf stated that signs are being vandalized - each time the town has to call Columbia County to replace a sign it costs the Town of West Point \$30.00 per sign.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to adjourn the meeting until October 10, 1985, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.
