

MINUTES FROM THE OCTOBER MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, October 10, 1985 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the September minutes, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The Treasurers Report was General-\$71,393.69; Holding Tank-\$251.36; and Tax Account-\$1,156.04. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the Treasurers report, 2nd by Alex Lochner-motion carried.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to pay the bills, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish had asked Marilyn Noble (realtor) to put a value on the four (4) acres that our landfill site is on - she put a value of \$6,000.00 on the land. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to present a offer to purchase the landfill site for \$6,000.00 to Mr. Hartmann the lawyer for the Rindle Estate, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

In the matter of Lee Rogers driveway problem with 220 ft. by 3 ft. wide that belongs to Dick Hegerfeld - a motion was made by Alex Lochner not to take action and to investigate further and talk to the attorney, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried. To be presented again at the November meeting.

The Lodi Fire Department presented the town with their Budget for 1986 as follows: Total Budget - \$71,117.00; West Point share of the Budget is \$10,223.40. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the Lodi Fire Budget, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The Sauk Prairie Fire Department presented the town with their budget for 1986 as follows: Total Budget - \$54,750.00; West Point's share is .025% mill. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the Sauk Prairie Fire Budget, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Lodi Ambulance budget was presented as follows: Total Budget - \$22,500 - with West Point's share \$4,500. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept Lodi Ambulance budget, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Sauk Prairie Ambulance presented the Town of West Point share of their budget as \$2,000.00. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to accept Sauk Praire Ambulance budget, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The billing of fire calls was discussed at great length- Mr. Meyer from Meyer Insurance company in Sauk City was present also and gave his views on billing. It was decided to bill property owners for the fire run and if not paid to put on tax roll.

Some West Point residences has asked the town for money for a caterpillar to level the fill that is being dredged ~~for~~from the Lake <sup>Wisconsin</sup> to Dave Schoepp land. A motion was made by Alex Lochner not to give any money as it was a private group that would benefit, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.
