

MINUTES FROM SPECIAL TOWN MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town of West Point held a Special Town Meeting on Thursday, November 7, 1985 at 7:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. 24 people were present.

The minutes were read from the April 9, 1985 meeting, a motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A motion was made by Hal Minkler to put Federal Revenue Sharing money towards highway repairs, 2nd by Tom Eberle. Yes 22 No - 0 motion carried.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to call a special town meeting for the purpose of discussing going from a 3 member board to a 5 member board, 2nd by Hal Minkler. Yes - 18 No - 0 motion carried.

The 1986 Budget was presented - a total budget of \$120,250.00 less revenue from state of \$57,049.12 and money left from 1985 of \$30,000.00 leaving the total tax levy for the Town of West Point of \$35,200.88.

A letter was read from the Rindle Estate refusing the town's offer of \$6,000.00 for 4 acres. After some discussion a motion was made by Alfred Smith to counter offer of \$10,000.00 for 10 acres, 2nd by Jack Bates Yes-23 No 1 motion carried.

A motion was made by Bob Lichte to adjourn the Special Town Meeting until December 5, 1985 at 7:30 p.m., 2nd by Hal Minkler - motion carried.
