

MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY MEETING

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, February 6, 1986 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Margaret Hanson-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer-Assessor and Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the minutes, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to pay the bills, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Discussion of purchasing the Sanitary Landfill was \$25,000.00 for 12 or possible more acres, Rindle Estate to pay for surveying cost and to bring the deed up to date; the township to test the wells near the Sanitary Landfill (the two wells on the Rindle Farm - possible one of Mr. Zemans wells and Dan Schoepp's well) at a price of \$160.00 per well (plus \$130.00 for a V.O.C. test). The town to close by the end of March, 1986. if necessary

Bob Buchanan would like to rezone 3 or 4 acres to commercial and recreational to build a airplane hanger for 2 or 3 planes, and mini warehouses. He presented the town board with the plans and the clerk to make copies and send the plans to Harry, John, and Earl. The rezoning will be put on the agenda for March meeting.

There will be a Spring Primary Election for the Sauk Prairie School Board - a motion was made by Alex Lochner to have 3 person to work at the polls and furnish the evening meal - 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The audit report was read from William Campbell and Associates, the town board, clerk and treasurer would like to meet with the William Campbell and Associates to discuss the audit report.

Chairman John Benish to call the Columbia County Sherriff's department and see if something can be worked out for this area in communication so the people do not have to pay long distance. Also Mr. Kiddle to get hold of County Supervisor to ask them for help with a toll free number.

Chairman John Benish to check and see if a Mobile Home is legally parked near Hickory Hills Resort.

Maurice Neumaier asked Chairman John Benish to sign a permit for fireworks on the 4th of July in Prairie du Sac for the VFW. Chairman John Benish stated that the permit Mr. Neumaier brought in was not a legal permit - he will bring one to the March meeting - and it will be put on the adgenda also.
