

MINUTES FROM THE MARCH MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, March 6, 1986 at 8:00 p.m. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Harry Sawyer-Assessor and Margaret Hanson-Treasurer was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four (4) places.

A motion was made to approve the minutes with correction by Alex Lochner, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The Treasurers Report was given as follows:
General - \$400,491.12 (includes tax collections), Tax Account-\$1,211.67 (interest on tax collections), Holding Tank-\$258.49
A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the treasurers report, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf to pay the bills - motion carried.

The ordinance on Fire Codes has not been completed - it will be put on the agenda for the April meeting. It is a Ordinance drawn up with Town of Lodi, City of Lodi and Town of West Point to adopt same codes as the State has and can be enforced by the municipalities, there are a few business places that are in violation.

The V.F.W. in Sauk City would like to have fireworks on July 5, 1986 - the Town of West Point is having the Wisconsin Towns Association lawyer (Rick Stadelman) writing up an Ordinance on fireworks to have at our April meeting. The V.F.W. also needs to take out insurance on the township - Maurice Neumaier to talk to the V.F.W. about insurance. The fireworks permit is tabled until the April meeting.

Bob Buchanan explained his proposed plan for mini warehouses and airplace hanger. The town board decided to meeting on Wednesday, March 26, 1986 at 1:30 p.m. to look at the proposed land site.

An ordinance of work under \$200.00 doesn't have to go out on bid was presented - after some discussion it was decided to table this ordinance until our April meeting.

A resolution for borrowing money for the Purchase of the Sanitary Landfill was presented. A motion was made to adopt the Resolution 3/86 by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Alex Lochner - a voice vote was taken - Earl Lanzendorf - Yes, Alex Lochner - Yes, and John Benish - Yes - the resolution 3/86 borrowing money for purchase of landfill was adopted.

A Class B Beer License application for the Boardwalk Resort was presented - owner Lester Hach. Some of the board have looked at the Boardwalk Resort and would like to wait to issue the Class B Beer License until the resort is ready for operation. The clerk to inform Lester Hach to let the board know when it is ready for operation and they will investigate. Also the Operators Licenses, Soda License and Cigarette License was not issued at this time.

A Resolution in reference to Development in the Town of West Point without proper Zoning was presented - after some discussion the Resolution was tabled to be rewritten and presented again at the April meeting.

Discussion of a Trailer Ordinance that was Passed by the Town of West Point on April 25, 1970 and was published on April 30, 1970 to be enforced as of May 1, 1970. The clerk was instructed to make copies of the Trailer Ordinance and sent to Mr. Bud Styer, Mr. Earl Schoepp and Mr. Richard Hegerfeld that this Ordinance will be discussed at the April Town Board Meeting.

Corine Hutter a candidate for Sauk Prairie school board introduced herself to the Town Board and other people present. She expressed her views and asked if the town board had any suggestions to help the school board.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to pay for the meals of the election workers at the April 1, 1986 election, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried. The next Town Board Meeting will be WEDNESDAY, April 2, 1986 at 8:00 p.m. The Annual Town Meeting will be Tuesday, April 8, 1986 at 8:00 p.m.
