

MINUTES FROM THE AUGUST MEETING
TOWN OF WEST POINT

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held its regular monthly meeting on Thursday, August 7, 1986 at 8:30 p.m. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Alex Lochner-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read - a motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was as follows: General-\$131,980.74; and the Holding Tank-\$265.78. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the treasurers report, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish reported that the Sanitary Landfill was inspected and passed the report.

A motion was made by Alex Lochner to pay the bills, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Bob Daehling Jr. from Daehling Insurance Agency was at the meeting and he explained why our Public officials and employees liability has gone up so much, we were in a locked in policy for three years from 1983 - 1986 and now our insurance has gone to rates for 1987 which is \$2,163.00 A motion was made by Alex Lochner to approve the policy and the premium for 1986-87, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The weed spraying has been done on Van Ness Road and O'Connor Road. The spray can be purchased from our town chairman for \$33.00 per gallon.

Albany Industries did some cracks in the roads at Aleray Subdivision on a trial bases to see how the sealant stands up to weather and traffic.

Resolution 52-86 from Columbia County on Animal Shelter was presented- after a lot of discussion - A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to disapprove the resolution as it should be a municipality problem not a county problem, 2nd by Alex Lochner - motion carried unanimously.

The following operator licenses were presented for Woodlake Trails - Mary Styer, Tammie Feiner, and Arvesta M. Penewell. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to grant the licenses, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf, motion carried.

A picnic beer license was presented for Lake Wisconsin Boat Club on August 16, 1986. A motion was made by Alex Lochner to grant the one day picnic license, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish had a few announcements -

That the Town of West Point ranked 7th in Columbia County on road spending.

On August 12, 1986 the candidates for Columbia County Sheriff will be at the legion hall - everyone is invited.

On August 11, 1986 is the annual meeting for the Lodi School budget.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to adjourn the meeting, 2ndy by Alex Lochner - motion carried. The next meeting will be September 4, 1986 at 8:30 p.m.
