

TOWN OF WEST POINT
MINUTES FROM SPECIAL AUGUST MEETING

The town board of the Town of West Point held a special meeting on Thursday, August 27, 1987 at 7:30 p.m. at the Lichte property. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer-Assessor and Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The town board decided to have Columbia county engineer come and look at the water problem and give the board a approximate cost of fixing the problem to put in the budget for 1988. The public boat landing needs repair and needs to have some dirt cleaned out because the water is very shallow at the landing - John Benish will talk to D.N.R. about the problem.

The Class B Beer license for Broadwalk Resort was discussed- it is unclear if they want a Class B or Class A. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to table the license until September 3, 1987 meeting, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The Don Moore property was discussed. A motion was made to contact Janice Moore again stating that due to neighbors complaints about rodents if the town board didn't hear from her by September 15, 1987 the town would contact a company to get^{id} of the rodents and put the cost on the tax bill by John Benish, 2nd by Fred Thistle- motion carried.

Terry Hillestad explained what Slack's Inc. would like to build 24x64 building to add to plant operations. Slack's Inc was grandfather in - but due to the clause can not add a new building with out being zoning^{ed} commercial. Therefore he is asking to have 1.66 acres rezoned from agricultural to commercial. Two letters were read from neighbors asking not to approve the rezoning. A motion was made by John Benish to table the rezoning until after the September 1, 1987 hearing at Columbia County, 2nd by Fred Thistle. *motion carried.*
