

TOWN OF WEST POINT
MINUTES FROM THE SEPTEMBER MEETING

The Town Board of the Town of West Point held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday, September 3, 1987 at 8:30 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes from the August 6, 1987 meeting was read. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. The minutes from the August 27, 1987 meeting was read. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was as follows: General-\$28,129.60; Holding Tank-\$479.72; a motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to accept the Treasurers report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The following bills were presented:

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the bills presented with the exception of the Lodi Fire Department assessment bill for clarification, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to appoint a committee to go over the public nuisance ordinance of Bud Styer, Hal Minker and Esther Thistle and bring the revised ordinance to the town boards October 8 meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish explained that the revised Mobile Home Park Ordinance was not back from the attorney - therefore the ordinance will be on the October agenda to go over and finalize. After which there will be a meeting with the park owners for clarification.

After some discussion of the Rezoning of Ethel Slack of Slack's Inc. from Agricultural to Commercial - a motion was made by John Benish to rezone from Agricultural to Commerical as 24 x 64 plus loading area with the stipulation that the present owner must inform the town board before the time of the sale what is the intention of purchaser for future use of property, 2nd by Fred Thistle - a roll call vote was taken as follows: Fred Thistle - Yes; Earl Lanzendorf - Yes; and John Benish - Yes - motion carried.

A letter was received from Woodlake Trails asking to have the liquor license description changed to include the Hangar and surrounding entertainment area (hill). After discussion the liquor license description was tabled until October meeting.

The town board signed a letter from Madison Gas & Electric stating that natural gas would be put in on Golf Road.

The Class B Beer License from Broadwalk Resort was asked to be changed to a Class A package Beer License by Lester Hach. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to issue that Broadwalk Resort a Class A Beer License, 2nd by John Benish - the motion was carried with one member opposing the license.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to have Columbia County do shoulder work on Barta Road, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

One operator license was presented for Bettina Hach. A motion was made by John Benish to grant the license, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish stated that the striping on Gannon Road will be done around September 15 by the State of Wisconsin.

Pine Vista has asked to have a street light put on the corner of Highway 60 and Golf Road. Chairman John Benish will look into having a annual fee charged. Woodlake Trails would also like a street light put on Gannon Road.

A motion was made by John Benish to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. The next meeting will be on October 8, 1987 at 8:00 p.m.
