MINUTES FROM SPECIAL NOVEMBER MEETING

The town board of the Town of West Point held a special meeting on Tuesday, November 17, 1987 at 8:10 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish - Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor,

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adopt the town budget as presented (\$152,150.00), 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to adopt a resolution for paying the first ($\frac{1}{2}$) half of real estate taxes by February 29, 1988, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to adopt a resolution for paying State and County Taxes if the Treasurer fails to do so (\$149,569.31), 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to add the words JUNK VEHICLES to the Public Nuisance Ordinance Section 4 (g), 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
