MINUTES FROM MARCH MEETING

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, March 3, 1988 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Harry Sawyer-Assessor; Joan Bader-Treasurer and Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor were absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes from the February 4 meeting were read, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried. The minutes from the special February meeting were read, a motion was made by John Benish, to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was as follows - General - \$20,370.25; Holding Tank - \$491.58. A motion was made by John Benish to approve the Treasurers report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A letter was read asking the Fjords Road be blacktopped. Some checking into cost etc. will be done at a later date.

Information was presented on cost of having the towns own police department - it will be brought up at the special town meeting in April.

The following bills were presented:

- Glen Clark (work at landfill) - \$160.00

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the bills, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have one voting booth widen for handicapped, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A resolution from the Grade Boat Club was presented asking to have Channel Marker Buoys Installed on the Wisconsin River, after a lot of discussion about liability to the town, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the resolution, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to furnish one meal for election workers at the April 5 election, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to have 5 persons work at election on April 5, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to allow the town clerk to help with the tallying of election, 2nd by John Benish motion carried.

A resolution for posting of all meetings was presented (3-88) which stated that the town clerk will post the notices. A motion was made by John Benish to adopt the resolution, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

State Representative Dave Travis gave the people present information on the State Budget and answered questions.

The V. F. W. from Sauk Prairie are going to have Fireworks on the 4th of July again.

Any person that is attending a meeting that is for the Town of West Point is covered by the town's insurance.
