

TOWN OF WEST POINT
MINUTES FROM ANNUAL MEETING

The Town of West Point held its Annual Town meeting on Tuesday - April 12, 1988 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. 31 people were present.

The notice was published in the Lodi Enterprise and Sauk Prairie Star.

The minutes were read from the November 17, 1987 meeting. A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to approve the minutes, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The financial report was presented and explained to the people. A motion was made by William Drake to accept the financial report, 2nd by Rudy Oest - motion carried.

A motion was made by Gordon Parks to donate \$175.00 to the Garden Bluff Cemetary Fund, 2nd by Harry Sawyer - motion carried.

A motion was made by Harry Sawyer to donate \$200.00 to the Lodi Fair Association, 2nd by Esther Thistle - motion carried.

Discussion of hiring a constable for the Town of West Point - A motion was made by William Rohlwing to look in the general cost of hiring a constable, 2nd by William Drake - Yes - 31 = No - 0 = motion carried.

The following note was received- We (Pine Vista) move that the Town Board of West Point call a special meeting by July 1st, 1988. We request a special Town Board meeting with a state tax assessor who is knowledgeable of details on assessing mobile homes; giving answers to all questions regarding the evaluation of mobile homes for tax purposes, and we would also like our township assessor present-to be held at Pine Vista recreational room. Also discussion of Mobile Home Parking Fee. A motion was made by William Drake to have a special meeting, 2nd by William Rohling; Yes-31=No-0 - motion carried. The clerk to notify Woodlake Trails, Cottonwood Resort and Pine Vista of date, time of meeting etc.

Page 2 - Annual Town Meeting - April 12, 1988

Asked about having a street light put up on Hwy. 60 and Golf Road corner. Chairman John Benish will check into liability and insurance of the street light and bring the information back to a town board meeting.

Buoys - lighted or autovisible was brought up - Bob Thompson is checking in to the liability and will get back to the 5 (five) towns involved.

A motion was made by William Rohling to adjourn the Annual Town Meeting, 2nd by Gordon Parks - motion carried.
