

MINUTES FROM SPECIAL TOWN BOARD MEETING  
TOWN OF WEST POINT

A special town board meeting was held on Monday - May 10, 1988 at Pine Vista at 8:00 p.m. The members present were:; John Benish-Chairman, Earl Lanzendorf - 1st Supervisor, Fred Thistle - 2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer. Eugene Miller from Department of Taxation was also present.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places. 70 people were present.

The meeting was turned over to Eugene Miller for questions on assessments etc. from the people present. Mr. Miller explained that Mobile Home values were based on sales of other mobile homes.

The mobile home parking fee was brought up - Mr. Miller stated the the State of Wisconsin sets up that 12 monthly payment be made instead of 1 payment a year, that way the assessor can keep a better control of buying and selling of mobile homes.

A lot more discussion followed. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting - 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.
