

TOWN OF WEST POINT  
MINUTES FROM SEPTEMBER MEETING

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, September 8, 1988 at 8:00 p.m. at the Town Hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes from the August 4th meeting were read, a motion by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The treasurer's report was as follows: General-\$43,680.42; Holding Tank-\$504.07. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to accept the treasurers report, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf-motion carried.

A motion was made by John Beniah to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Mr. Jay D. Moretti-candidate for Representation to the Assembly in the 81st district from Cross Plains presented his goals and believes for local government and to keep lines open, also answered questions from people that were present.

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to enforce the Mobile Home Parking Ordinance as of January 1, 1989, 2nd by John Benish, after discussion a roll call vote was taken as follows: Fred Thistle - No, Earl Lanzendorf - Yes and John Benish - Yes, motion was carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the rezoning of James Jensen from Agricultural to Single Family Residence, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the rezoning of Judy Buchanan from Agricultural to Commercial (3 $\frac{1}{4}$  acres), 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A letter was received about a lot of junk (old boiler, tires, etc) on lot #64 the owner is Mitchell Greimel from the residents on Rausch Road - A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to have a letter sent to Mr. Greimel to have 30 days to dispose of the junk and straighten up the lot, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A permit for Madison Gas and Electric to have natural gas put on Selwood Drive and Gastrow Road was granted.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have 3 people to work at the September election and 14 people to work split shifts at the November election, also to open election at 8:00 a.m. at the November election, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to buy the meals for the September election, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

Applications for county board supervisor to represent the Town of West Point will be received by the county clerk from anyone interested to fill the vacancy for Bob Lichte until September 16, 1988

A motion was made by Earl Lanzendorf to have speed limit signs put up in Pleasant View Park for 25 MPH and also signs reading caution children at play, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The ordinance to have the town chairman write violation is tabled until another fall meeting.

The town board asked to have Mike Clark come to the next town board meeting to report on grass cuttings, batteries etc. that he doesn't want at the town landfill.

A motion was made by John Benish to have Fred Thistle to follow up with D.N.R. on possible tire removal, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf, motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.
