

TOWN OF WEST POINT  
MINUTES FROM THE FEBRUARY MEETING

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, February 9, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, Harry Sawyer-Assessor; Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes from the January 5, 1989 meeting, a motion was made by John Benish, 2nd by Fred Thistle-motion carried.

The Treasurer's Report was as follows: General Account-\$380,737.70 (\$25,813.46 town money); Holding Tank Account-\$616.89; a motion was made by John Benish to accept the report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The bills were presented (see sheet attached); a motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the bills presented, 2nd by John Benish, motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to have 3 people work at the election and furnish one meal for workers, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to approve the proposed amendments to chapter 11 of Columbia County Zoning Rules, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A letter was received from the commissioner of transportation (Joseph Sweda) that a petition was filed asking for determination as to whether existing protective devices are adequate on county truck "V". Chairman John Benish stated that the town would be told when the public hearing would be held.

The town board will hold a special meeting to go and look at the town roads to see which ones need brushing and put a letter in the papers asking people who are interested to bid on the brushing.

The Town of Lodi, City of Lodi and Town of West Point are going to look at the Town of Oregon on the 16th of February to see how they are operating their Transfer Site. The week of the 20th of February the town board will meet with Eder Associate Consulting Enneers and Northern Environmental Technologies to see their cost and what they need to do the close our sanitary landfill.

A Town Ordinance on Town Roads was presented - the town board will review the ordinance and present it at a later meeting for approval.

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Robert and Regina Karls asked for a variance on their property on highwqy 188 (the old marina). The hearing will be on February 16, 1989 at the Columbia County Administration Building.

A motion was made by John Benish to adjorun the meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
