

TOWN OF WEST POINT
MINUTES FROM THE APRIL MEETING

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday, April 6, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Earl Lanzendorf-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes from the March 9, 1989 meeting were read, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes, 2nd Earl Lanzendorf-motion carried.

The minutes from the March 16, 1989 bid opening was read, a motion was made by John Benish to approve the minutes, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was as follows: General-\$42,811.61; Holding Tank-\$616.89. A motion was made by John Benish to accept the Treasurers report, 2nd by Earl Lanzendorf - motion carried

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have the treasurer have the attorney take 3 unpaid personnel property taxes to small claims court, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A letter was received from DNR on shredding tires - it will be kept on file.

The bills were presented, a motion was made by John Benish to pay the bills with the exception of the Lodi Enterprise, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The clerk installed the new town officers, they are as follows: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, A. David Cole-2nd Supervisor, and Joan Bader-Treasurer.

Resolution #4-89 was read (for Earl Lanzendorf who was supervisor for 14 years), a motion was by John Benish to adopt the resolution, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The town chairman has not heard for Mr. Carter on the fire call made to his property in 1988 - it will now be turned over to the lawyer.

Fred Thistle gave a report on the Landfill, the town needs to contact DNR to see we need a closure plan or not by April or June, 1991. Chairman John Benish has contacted Carl Roovers from the DNR at Horicon and he is coming to look at the landfill on April 11, 1989.

A resolution to Columbia County on extending days for Zoning Amendments from 10 to 20 days was read - a motion was made by Fred Thistle to adopt the resolution, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

It was decided to active the Citizens Committee - there will be a meeting at the Town Hall on April 26, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. to discuss the Sanitary Landfill.

Mr. Richard Landgraf, Mr. Vedvig and Mrs. McAnaugb asked the town board to vacate the road known at East Harmon Road from Hwy. 188 to the Wisconsin River. They asked Chairman John Benish to send them copies of the Certified Survey from Ron Marks and any other information the town may have. Chairman John Benish stated that he would send them all the information he has and that he was going to have a meeting with Mr. Jeff Clark on Friday-April 7, 1989 the town lawyer to discuss East Harmon Road.

A motion was made by John Benish to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
