

TOWN OF WEST POINT
MINUTES FROM THE SPECIAL JUNE MEETING

The town board of the Town of West Point held a special meeting on Monday - June 26, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

William Casey from Columbia County recycling gave a presentation to the people present on how the recycling of plastic, cans, bottles, papers etc. are handled. He stated that West Point is doing a good job of recycling.

The following applications were received from Georgette Jackson, Ernest Wunsch, Jeffrey Krummenaur, Leon Kleinert, Kenneth Whitmore, Heather White, Thomas Ballweg, Stacy Rothman, Michelle Price, Carmen Feight, and David Miller for Lake Wisconsin Country Club. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the licenses, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The following application from Jeanette Langdon for Schoepps Cottonwood Resort was received. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the license, 2nd by Dave cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to rescind the 6-20-89 resolution to disapprove the rezoning for Lucille Weynand, 2nd by John Benish - Yes - 2 and No 1 - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to allow a 1/2 acre to be rezoned to residential presently were the house stood, 2nd by Fred Thistle - Yes 2 - No 1 - the motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to go into closed session to confer with and receive advice from legal counsel regarding East Harmon Road and to reconvene to open session, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to instruct legal counsel to meet with all interested property owners and/or their attorneys to attempt to settle the East Harmon Road dispute by confirming the town's road easement of sufficient width to preserve the present and all future public safety and access to the lake and if purposed settlement is not brought back to the board by legal counsel within a reasonable period of time, legal counsel shall commence a law suit to establish the town's continuing interest in East Harmon Road, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

If anyone has knowledge of vandalism on East Harmon Road - please call the sheriff - complaint forms are at Hickory Hill to fill out.

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A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Dave Cole, - motion carried.
