The minutes from the June 26, 1989 meeting were read, a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to have a Gas Main Extension for Hillcrest Drive, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Dave Cole, motion carried.

The following operator licenses was presented from Woodlake Trails - Lisa Palmer, Kris Markgraf, Michael Jeffers - a motion was made by John Benish to grant the licenses - 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The annual meeting for Sauk Prairie School will be on July 24, 1989.

There is a bill in the Wisconsin Legislator to allow towns to publish town records in papers such as the Stopper Shopper. A motion was made to table this until a later date by John Benish, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to have the east end of the sanitary landfill backfilled by Earl Lanzendorf, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to appoint Don Bohler to the Sauk Prairie Fire Board for the next two years, 2nd by John Benish motion carried.

The model Ordinance of Development of Town Road in Residential Areas was tabled until the here from the lawyer.

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A motion was made to pay the ambulance bill for Frieda Mielke and to send a letter stating that if the bill is not paid to the town it will be put on the tax bill by Dave Cole, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Public access in Pleasant View Circle - Mrs. Louise Brishkie would like to purchase the public access from the town of West Point - also Ken Nonn was drilling a well not on his property - he is going to have the property surveyed and would purchase the land that he needs to buy. A motion was made by Dave Cole to table this until the August meeting to have more information on the public access - 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Mr. Rich Marks presented the assessor plat that was ready to send to the State of Wisconsin for approval. A motion was made to approve the assessor plat presented and sign a letter and forward it to the state for approval by John Benish - 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried. Also a motion was made by Dave Cole to pay the \$505.00 fee for the assessor plat and to have the property owners reimburse the town of West Point, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Mr. Robert Daehling from Daehling Insurance came before the board with a bid of \$2,025.00 for the Town of West Point insurance for the next year. A motion was made by Dave Cole to reopen the insurance at the August meeting, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A letter was received with complains of two dogs in Pleasant View Park (James Meisterer and Jeff Zersen). A letter will be sent to each owner stating they have one week to get their dogs under control and to keep them under control at all times.
