The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on ~~Tuesday~~ <sup>Thursday</sup> September 7, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes from the August 3 meeting were read - a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The minutes from the August 8th meeting were read - a motion was made by John Benish to approve the minutes, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The treasurer's report was as follows: General - #31,996.17; Holding Tank - \$632.40; a motion was made by Fred Thistle to accept the treasurer's report, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made to take \$4,000.00 from the Highway Maintenance account and put it in the Highway Construction by Dave Cole, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the bills presented, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The Environment Sub Committee was tabled but the following names of people who would be interested in being on the committee are as follows: Bill Welsh, Allen Boehmer, Mike Reichman and Kevin Kochaver (Fjords Road).

Cecelia Bishop has moved out of the town and is no longer interested in being dog catcher.

Chairman John Benish will be calling a special meeting later on in September with the citizens committee and the town board to discuss the Sanitary Landfill.

The soldiers graves letter was signed and will be sent to Carol Vogt the Columbia County Clerk.

The D.N.R. agreement for a pier on East Harmon Road access was tabled until the October meeting to have a representative present at the meeting from D.N.R.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to table the "NO WAKE" ordinance on Lake Wisconsin, if there is a problem in the Spring a public hearing should be held, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
