

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday - November 9, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the October 3, 1989 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle and 2nd by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as read - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the October 24, 1989 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle and 2nd by Dave Cole to approve the minutes as corrected - motion carried.

The Treasurers Report was as follows: General-\$14,328.00; Holding Tank - \$632.40; a motion was made by Dave Cole to accept the treasurers report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The bills were presented and a motion was made by John Benish, to pay the bills, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Chuck Zeman came on behalf of the Lodi Fire Department who would like to buy a new fire rescue truck in 1992. There would be an assessment in 1991 and 1992 of \$3,000.00 each year. The town board said that they would go along with the purchase of the new rescue truck.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to grant a variance (no permanent structure) for Karen Hamilton on Smith Park Road, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The moratorium on Farm Lands was discussed - the clerk was asked to contact the clerk from Dekorra to get the point system.

A motion was made by John Benish to write off Lane, Riggins, Dubel, Rapean, Shysmere as bad debts on personal property, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

There will be a public hearing on the closing of the Sanitary Landfill on November 16, 1989 at 7:30 p.m.

A resolution for taxes was presented a motion was made by Fred Thistle approve the resolution, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have John Benish - Chairman to contact the property owners on Bachelor Lane to come to the December meeting - 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

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There will be "NO PARKING" signs put up on Gannon Road.

East Harmon Road will be tabled until the December meeting with a decision made at that time.

A motion was made by Dave Cole that the town board of West Point goes on record in favor of eduction of hazard material on premises, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.
