

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held there regular monthly meeting on Thursday - December 7, 1989 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the November 9, 1989 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was as follows: General - \$35,469.45, Holding Tank - \$648.47; a motion was made by Fred Thistle to accept the treasures report, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The bills were presented and a motion was made by John Benish to pay the bills, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

There was a complaint of junk on the Griemel Property on Rausch Road - Chairman John Benish went and looked over the property and his recommendation was to take no action at this time.

There was a complaint of the junk vehicles on the Rodenschmit property on Hwy. 60 - Chairman John Benish had checked out the property and found that most of the junk vehicles had been hauled away - Mrs. Rodenschmit stated that they will continue to improve - therefore the recommendation was no action be taken at this time.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to table the moratorium on farm lands until the January meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Bachelor Lane was tabled until January meeting.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle our attorney proceed to take whatever action is needed to protect the interest of the town in use and ownership of East Harmon Road, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was also made by Fred Thistle to have a meeting with all property owners and their lawyers and all the town board and the town board attorney to sit down and talk about East Harmon Road after January 1st, 1990, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Don Walker from the University of Wisconsin is going to help the town clerk set up a computer program for all the West Points town roads.

A motion was made by John Benish to permit Madison Gas to put gas line in on Hwy. 188, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
