The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday - March 8, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish - Chairman, Fred Thistle - 1st Supervisor, Dave Cole - 2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Harry Sawyer - Assessor and Joan Bader - Treasurer was absent.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the February 8, 1990 meeting, a motion was made Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the February 20, 1990 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as corrected, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The minutes were read from the ~~March~~ ^{February} 23, 1990 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurer's report was as follows: General - \$63,650.57, the Holding Tank - \$648.47; a motion was made by John Benish to approve the Treasurer's Report, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A letter was received from Columbia County Humane Society stating that they have an employee that will pick up stray dogs for the town. The town board will do so checking into the cost etc. of having the Humane Society pick up the dogs and bring it to the April meeting.

If Don Fulkerson has not paid is bad check bill that he owes the town - the town will put a lean on his mobile home. We will check with the town treasurer to see if he has paid the bill before anything is done.

Mr. Phil Fish gave a slide presentation on the Grand Avenue School. There will be a referendum ballot at the April election on the building of a new school to replace the Grand Avenue School.

Mr. Gordon Gorsuch would like a variance off Lake Drive to put up a two car garage and storage building about 20 ft. from the road edge. a motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the building of the garage, 2nd by John Benish, Yes - 2 and No - 1 - motion carried.

Bently Lein from Columbia County as Community Development and Resource Agent gave a presentation different subjects such as the watertable level is down 8 foot from normal and on the waste disposal plant.
