

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held the regular monthly meeting on Thursday - April 5, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The member present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer, and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the March 7, 1990 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes as read, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was as follows: General - \$52,931.81; Holding Tank - \$648.47; a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the Treasurer's Report, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish stated the Hwy. 60 from Hwy. 188 to the city limits of Lodi will be resurfaced in 1995.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the #2-90 Ordinance on Separation and Recycling with additions, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried. The ordinance will take affect upon being published.

The moratorium was tabled until a later date.

The clean sweep program is only for household hazardous waste - not for farmers therefore will help the town.

There were 10 people present from Pleasant View Park about the dogs running at large. After a lot of discussion the town clerk was instructed to write letters to 3 people who's dogs are known to running at large to control their dogs to their property if not taken care immediately there will be a fine and plenty made. There will also be a meeting on Friday, April 13, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall to talk about dogs.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to have the stop sign on Davis Road near Hickory Hill moved backwards 10 feet, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to table the filling in of road side ditch on Gastrow Road by Tom Colestad until the May meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Mr. Don Krutchen came before the town board asking to have one acre of land rezoned from Agricultural to Single Family Residence, he would like to sell 10 - 12 acres to his brother and sister in law and they would like to build a house on Hwy. 60. This will be tabled until the May 2nd meeting so the town board has time to look over the property.

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Chairman John Benish stated that Mr. Jim Meister has asked the town board to allow him to place a mobile home on the Rasmussen property on Hwy. V for a office for his business not to be lived in. The board asked to have Mr. Meister to come before the town board.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve a garage 24 x 24 for Mr. Bob Erickson in Pleasant View Park, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

Chairman John Benish stated the due to E.P.A. regulation that it is necessary for the Town of West Point to borrow money. This will be brought up at the annual meeting on April 10, 1990. Dave Cole is to have some soil samples take and have them tested before the annual meeting also.

A motion was made by John Benish to have the Columbia County Humane Society put up our dogs, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Schoepps Cottonwood Resort presented two operator licenses for Peter and Paul Schoepp - a motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the licenses, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.
