

TOWN OF WEST POINT

~~The annual meeting of the~~ Town of West Point held its Annual Town Meeting on Tuesday, April 10, 1990 at the Town Hall. Eight people were present.

The notice was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star for two weeks, and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the November 16, 1989 meeting. A motion was made by Tom Eberle to approve the minutes, 2nd by Dave Cole - Yes 8 No 0 motion carried.

A motion was made by Esther Thistle to allow the town board to borrow up to \$80,000.00 for the closing of the Sanitary Landfill, 2nd by Tom Eberle - Yes 8 No 0 motion carried.

Dave Cole had soil samples taken and sent to a lab for testing and the findings are that we have 2 feet of usable clay which is suitable for closing of the landfill. A motion was made by John Benish to pay for the soil testing, 2nd by Harry Sawyer - Yes 8 No 0 motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to donate \$200.00 to the Lodi Fair Association, 2nd by Harry Sawyer - Yes 8 No 0 motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to donate \$175.00 to the Garden Bluff Association , 2nd by Harry Sawyer - Yes 8 No 0 motion carried.

A motion was made by John Benish to match highway funds with Columbia County, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

It was brought up about raising the salaries for the town officers - following a survey that was done by the Wisconsin Towns Association - after discussion - A motion was made by Tom Eberle to raise the salaries as follows:

- Chairman from 2,000.00 to 2,400.00
- Supervisors from 1,100.00 to 1,200.00
- Clerk from 3,200.00 to 4,000.00
- Treasurer from 2,000.00 to 2,400.00
- Assessor from 3,500.00 to 4,000.00

the motion was 2nd by Esther Thistle - Yes 5, No 3, motion carried. The salary increase doesn't take affect until April, 1991.

John Benish stated the D.N.R. will be developing the public access in Okee - therefore the town of West Point will have to update Old Sauk Road which will cost approximately 6,000.00. We have 5,500.00 in a highway account at Columbia county.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to adjourn the annual meeting, 2nd by Harry Sawyer - motion carried.
