

TOWN OF WEST POINT

The town board of the Town of West Point held their regular monthly meeting on Thursday - June 7, 1990 at 8:00 p.m. at the town hall. The members present were: John Benish-Chairman, Fred Thistle-1st Supervisor, A. Dave Cole-2nd Supervisor, Edith Eberle-Clerk, Joan Bader-Treasurer and Harry Sawyer-Assessor.

The meeting was published in the Lodi Enterprise and the Sauk Prairie Star and posted in four places.

The minutes were read from the May 3rd, 1990 meeting, a motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the minutes with correction, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The Treasurers report was as follows: General - \$51,233.62 and the Holding Tank - \$774.34. A motion was made by Fred Thistle to approve the treasurers report, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

There will be a public hearing held on June 20, 1990 at the Lodi Fire Station on the construction of Hwy. 60 that will be done in 1995.

The bills were presented and a motion was made by Fred Thistle to pay the bills presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to grant a Class B Beer and Liquor Licenses to Tri-J Inc. but to delete premises, Cigarette License, Pop License and the following Operator Licenses (Allen Reinke, Holly Schumann, Mark W. Bingham, Jeffrey Elser, Louis D. Mehlretter, Jill Daehling and Deanna White), 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant a Class B Beer License to Lake Wisconsin Marina, Inc. if the parking problem is straighten out, Cigarette Licenses, Pop License and the following Operator Licenses (Darren A. Shields, Maurice H. Cliff, Jeanne M. Humphrey, and Karen Pratt), 2nd by John Benish - motion carried.

The following operator licenses were presented from Schoepp's Cottonwood Resort Inc. - Jack E. Rapean, Pat Schoepp, Peter Schoepp, Paul Schoepp, Jeanette A. Langdon, David D. Carlson, Cynthia K. Miller, and Raymond A. Hanson; a motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the licenses presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

The following operator licenses were presented from Woodlake Trails Entertainment Inc. - Bud Styer, Mary Styer, Mary Stovall, Glenda Raas, Michelle M. Pieper, and Lisa M. Palmer; a motion was made by Fred Thistle to grant the licenses presented, 2nd by Dave Cole - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to approve the Fireworks on July 7th for Prairie du Sac V.F.W. - if they show proof of insurance to the town chairman, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

The disclaimer on Fjords Road is tabled until the July meeting.

Garden Bluff Cemetery was tabled until the July meeting at which time we will have someone from the cemetery association present.

It was reported that Lodi School budget was going up 12.9% and that Sauk Prairie School budget was going up 7%.

The Town of Roxbury has hired Wolf Paving to do a single seal on Schoepp Road this year and another coat next year. After discussion a motion was made by Dave Cole to have Scott Construction Co. do a double seal coat this year with the Town of Roxbury picking up half the cost of their share this year, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

Mr. Robert Daehling came before the town board asking that to have Overland Road vacated in Pleasant View Park. Mr. Daehling is going to draw up the proceedings to start to vacate Overland Road and that the people who are interested in buying the land and Mr. Daehling come back to the town board with the plans of the design of the road etc. for erosion and run off.

Resolution #6-7-90 was presented that would allow all town board members to pick up dogs in the Town of West Point. A motion was made by John Benish to adopt this resolution, 2nd by Dave Cole, motion carried.

Chairman John Benish stated that a little over one mile of Van Ness Road will be done with a new process of sealing the road.

D.N.R. has told the towns that by September 10, 1990 that all town landfills will be covered and seeded.

The public hearing on D.N.R. rezoning on East Harmon Road is tabled by a motion made by Dave Cole, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.

A motion was made by Dave Cole to adjourn the meeting, 2nd by Fred Thistle - motion carried.
